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PHILADELPHIA, Oct. 2 — Despite placing runners in the first two positions, Georgetown University's cross-country team fell, 26-33, today to Villanova in a dual meet here.

Sophomore Dave Dobrzynski finished first in 25:50, three seconds ahead of teammate Jim Peterson. The Wildcats took the next four positions, led by third-place finisher Jay Woods in 25:58.

Washington Club Wins

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ANNAPOLIS, OCT. 2—The Washington Running Club, with runners in the third through seventh positions, defeated the Navy cross-country team, 20-35, in an exhibition match today.

Dan Rincon of the Delaware Sports Club, competing by special invitation,

was the first finisher on the five-mile course with a time of 25:08.

Matt Welsh of Navy was second in 25:14 followed by five Washington Running Club participants. Bruce Robinson, Steve Mahieu, Cliff Kahouser and Steve Milmoe were all timed in 25:25 and Bill Delano finished in 25:40.

Gallaudet Runners Win

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WESTMINSTER, Md., Oct. 2—Gallaudet placed runners in eight of the top 19 positions to take a 26-30 cross-country win over host Western Maryland.

The top individual finisher was Western Maryland's Doug Rener in 33:46. The next three places went to Gallaudet runners Tom Drake in 33:57, David Gurley in 34:06 and Matt Gallo in 34:16.
