Maryland Runners Win

Maryland's cross-country teams opened their season with victories yesterday at College Park. The men defeated Richmond, 21-37, and Virginia, 20-39, while the women topped Richmond, 19-40, Virginia, 24-32, and the Washington Running Club, 20-41.

Richmond's Hillary Tuwei led the men with a time of 25:50 but Terps captured four of the next five positions. Virginia's Margael Groos posted the best women's time of 17:05.
